

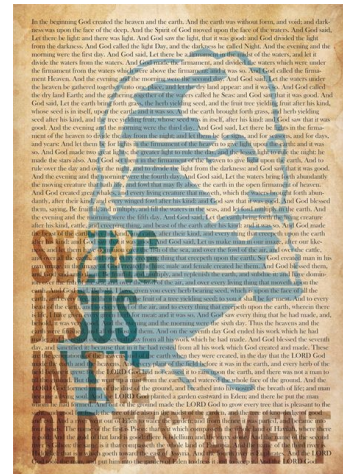

The Gospel of John: Baptism

CBI's Spring Seminar

On Saturday, April 28, 2018, the Concordia Bible Institute hosted a one-day seminar with Dr. William Weinrich, Professor of Early Church History and Patristic Studies at Concordia Theological Seminary in Fort Wayne, Indiana. Dr. Weinrich spoke to us about the Gospel of John with a focus on baptism, lecturing on such beloved texts as the baptism of Jesus, Jesus and Nicodemus, and the crucifixion.

One lasting impression that Dr. Weinrich's seminar left on me was the significance of a sacramental reading of the Bible. Terms like "water," "spirit," and "blood" in the Gospel of John (and beyond) can be so much more than what meets the eye. Consider, for example, how Jesus gives up his spirit before both water and blood pour from his side at the cross. This, Weinrich insists, indicates that the cross should be understood as a baptismal event, in which the church lives and moves and has its being. It's no wonder, then, why St. Paul would say that baptism unites us with Christ in a death like his (Rom. 6:5)!

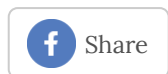
