


CBI e-Bulletin November 2018

Saleska Seminar Recap

On Saturday, October 13, we were pleased to host the Rev. Dr. Timothy Saleska, son of the founder and director emeritus of CBI, the Rev. Dr. John Saleska, for a seminar on the psalms. A number of participants shared with me their deep appreciation for Dr. Saleska's insights over the course of the seminar, and I, too, found his lectures to be quite edifying.

One highlight for me was how Dr. Saleska encouraged a slower, more indepth reading of the psalms. While we might be tempted to rush through a familiar text such as Psalm 23, Dr. Saleska made us carefully consider what are minds are doing when we think through the well-known phrase, "The Lord is my shepherd." What comes to mind first? Why might that be? What informs your thinking about shepherding? Do other biblical passages come into play, and if so, which ones?

One participant, for example, mentioned how the imagery of shepherding evoked for her God's leading and guiding throughout our lives. Someone else brought up the intimate bond that exists between a shepherd and sheep, and another emphasized deep care and compassion. Still another reflected on Jesus as the Good Shepherd, who goes like a lamb to the slaughter—a shepherd who chooses to shepherd by becoming a sheep!

Personally, I was struck by the preposition "my" in these opening words. The Lord, the almighty creator of heaven and earth, is also in some sense *mine*. The Lord shepherds in such a way that makes himself *mine*. When he shepherds, he lets me have him, as it were, to the extent that I can say that he's actually *mine*. His shepherding is *for* me, he shepherds to be *with* me, and he shepherds because he *loves* me.

How wonderful it was to have Dr. Saleska walk us through a familiar psalm in such a fresh way!
